IS THIS **A FAMINE**?

According to the technical definition of famine as outlined by the Integrated Phase Classification (IPC), **the current conditions in East Africa are listed as Emergency**, the fourth most severe classification.

It is vital that we respond to the deepening crisis before it becomes a famine.



FAMINE IS DEFINED AS:



At least 1 in 5 households faces an extreme lack of food.



More than 1 in 3 children under five are suffering from acute malnutrition.



At least 2 people out of every 10,000 are dying each day.
